Our Guest Speaker: Peter Schleifenbaum



Peter was born and raised in Germany and arrived in Canada with his young wife shortly after finishing his education. He is a professional forester with a PhD in forestry from a German university. He was an adjunct professor for forestry at UofT for over 20 years. He was the manager of Haliburton Forest and Wild Life Reserve for 30 years, a private forestry company owned by his family. Haliburton Forest today is comprised of 110,000 acres, is located in the northern Haliburton Highlands and is regarded as a model for integrated, sustainable resource management, bringing economic, social and environmental aspects of land use together in one management approach. Today he lives in Haliburton, but after 30 years of service has withdrawn from the active, day to day duties at Haliburton Forest. This gives him more opportunity to spend time with his family, 2 daughters and 3 grandchildren, as well as on the many other interests he has. He has travelled to many other countries over the years has been to such exotic places as the Comores, Madagascar, Eritrea, the Central African Republic and North Korea. He is very interested in politics, but also general environmental issues and works closely with a group in Nicaragua as well as one in Cameroon on socio-economic development, using forest/wood resources.
