**Wayne Klein** introduced our guest speaker, **Kevin Donovan** whose talk was entitled "Making a Difference, One Story at a Time".

Kevin spent 40 minutes recounting his journey from high school and university newspaper reporting and publishing, to his internship with the Toronto Star via a chance meeting with Peter Worthington. Kevin went on to describe some of his many experiences as a reporter covering war zones during the Gulf War and then, some years later in Afghanistan. Kevin also touched on the ups and downs of investigative reporting and went into some detail about the Sherman murders from 2 years ago. Kevin then answered a number of questions before being thanked by Wayne Klein.

Ron Wallace closed the meeting at 11:10am.

**Kevin Donovan** is the Toronto Star's Chief Investigative Reporter. His focus is on journalism that exposes wrongdoing and effects change. Over more than three decades he has reported on the activities of charities, government, police, business among other institutions. Donovan also reported

from the battlefields in the Gulf War and the war in Afghanistan following 9/11. He has won three National Newspaper Awards, two Governor General's Michener Awards, the Canadian Journalism Foundation award and three Canadian Association of Journalists Awards. As the Star's editor of investigations for many years, Donovan led many award-winning projects for the paper.

He is the author of several books including the National Best Seller, "The Billionaire Murders" detailing the case of Barry and Honey Sherman, "Secret Life" exploring the Jian Ghomeshi investigation and "Dead Times" a novel.


